Korean and Japanese University Students in Solidarity Protest Japan's Ongoing Colonialism

On August 21, a demonstration and parade was held around Shinjuku Station, Tokyo, organized by the Tolpa Project (a mass action by Korean and Japanese University students to remember the history of the massacre of Koreans in Japan and to oppose discrimination against Koreans), against the erasure of the historical facts and unfinished solution on the massacre of Koreans in Japan the Great Kanto Earthquake of 1923 by the Japanese government and the Tokyo Metropolitan Government. 150 people, mostly students and youth, participated in it, calling for “the Japanese government to inquire into the truth” and “the Tokyo Metropolitan Government should acknowledge the fact of the massacre.” (Shiso-Undo No. 1092, September 1, 2023)
